My background is more performance enhancement and hormone optimization. Anavar is a steroid derivative that was designed to be less androgenic so it could be given to women and children and not cause the negative side effects like deepening of the voice/hair growth etc. I coached female bodybuilders and they would use up to 5mg a day. A couple milligrams a week would be all that's needed for a healthy increase in a woman's libido.

I think a much better long term and medically tested method would be testosterone pellets. They are placed under the skin every few months and provide a very small amount of testosterone for the purpose of female hormone therapy.

The reason however why Anavar is superior is that testosterone is partially converted into estrogen via a human enzyme called aromatase. So while it would increase testosterone you'd see slight elevation in estrogen. All this is ok as long as everything stays in balance and at a small dose bloodwork would show you and your doctor how everything is looking so you can make adjustments.
