Quick announcement. We've brought TRPBOT over to asktrp to allow users to award eachother points for helpful or useful comments.

Unlike on [/r/theredpill](#) there are no minimum requirements like endorsed contributors or minimum number of points needed to award. Any user who feels that somebody else has posted a useful reply can award a point by adding the Mars symbol (type ♂ or type ALT + 11) ♂
