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take them fishing or hiking or play games with them or tickle them or play ball with them?

Obviously your kids are young. I get that this may not yet be a thing. Are you visiting them at their daycare for lunch? There are many ways to do all this, my specific ideas aren't the point, they are just stuff I've had success with. But I'm trying to help you understand how to evaluate whether you are actually OYS. Would your wife agree you're OYS?

I can't decide that. And your wife may not agree with you. This process is how you can decide if you're being reasonable, though. If your duties and responsibilities that you voluntarily took on are complete, then you can think about the stuff not required.
