These are the words that resonated with you when you were experiencing the events that lead up to you joining this community -- the Red Pill.

Consider that as you now know. This could have been prevented.

Behaviors in every single aspect of reality dictate your outcome, your "Matrix" of behaviors. You act to sell a product every day, and utilize highly effective and efficient behaviors each day **relative** to the outcome you are seeking, eventually that outcome will be produced.

The "Matrix" of behaviors.
