The gender-flipped version won't be about hair because women don't value appearance as highly. For women, what they value is status.

So here's a gender-flipped version: "I met a guy who runs a company and is active in politics - for the first year we were together, we were constantly going to events and rubbing shoulders with important people. Today, he told me he's withdrawing from public life and has sold his company. He wants to study Buddhism for a while, so he'll be staying home 7 days a week."

Question: does he need her permission to change up his social/professional/religious life? *Be serious man.*

The truth is, this is a change that's going to affect how attractive he is to that girl. He's free to do it anyway, of course. He doesn't "need her permission" - but one consequence of him doing it is, he might lose her.
