If someone has the ability to write quality content, all I want them to do is write quality content. 100% of their effort should be going towards that goal. But what does this man have to do? He has to post two disclaimers. He's already thinking about the backlash as he's posting the content. Then the next time he has a great idea to write a post, while also having other interesting things he can do in his life, he may choose the latter. Guess who's losing out on quality content.

Google human capital flight. Some of you may be familiar with the term "brain drain". Now you literally get to choose your future. Do you want those people to leave, or do you want them to stay around?

My advice to those in the community that need the red pill is as follows. Keep the high quality content providers here.

If someone posts something, don't try to find everything wrong in the post. There are 132K subscribers, who knows how many of those are active. But each one of the active ones has a view point. For every single thing posted, there will be men here who disagree with it due to their experiences. If you are one of those men, have some respect. Are you a man? Yes. So acknowledge the OP, state your point, and explain something. Don't just post one or two lines against what the OP said if the OP took an hour to write the post.

The core tenets of TRP today are the same as they were years ago. Most things are repeating what was already solidified years ago. Imagine 3 years ago you understood AWALT. For 3 years you have seen it play out over and over again in your life and your readings. It's synonymous with  $1+1=2$ . You're not going to be thinking about  $1+1=2$ , you're going to be thinking about what the next thing you can learn with the base knowledge of  $1+1=2$ . It's going to get more complicated. AWALT is already difficult to internalize. Knowledge building on top of AWALT is going to be even more difficult. Furthermore, knowledge building from multiple fundamental pieces of TRP is going to hurt your brain even more.

You're going to see new concepts. And because content creators will be thinking of new things, the discussion

will branch out further than simply AWALT, TRP is real, TRP works, etc. Be ready for that, read it, and have respect for the discussion. If you're going to add your input, make sure that you are adding value to the community with your input.

If you're new, read the side bar. Seriously. Read the side bar. It doesn't take that long. After you're done reading the sidebar, sort by top of all time and start reading some of the things from years ago. We had some raw discussions back in the day. They are just as relevant now. You will be much more ready to participate in this subreddit and offer actual value after a few weeks of heavy reading. Also, read rollo's blog. He is an artist with his words and can accurately portray an idea in his writing.

People cry sell out whenever you try to make money from your success. **But if they found themselves in your position in any capacity, even if it's a bit of mild internet success - they'd do exactly the same shit.** People don't like being charged for things that used to be free - but they also don't like seeing guys trying to make money out of things they never used to try to make money from, even when paying is optional! I'm probably going to start experimenting with ads on my blog soon, it's been ad free for 2 years. I tried going the Patreon route first, which I've had about 6 months now, and the growth on that is extremely humble. So it looks like I'm going to have to look at mixing revenue streams up.

I love the dudes who sponsor my work and am infinitely humbled by their support, there just isn't all that many of them. Out of all my monthly views (fuck it, let's say unique views) if I crunch the numbers about 0.001% support via Patreon. If we do it from followers to Patreon supporters that probably comes up to around 0.01%. IT'S definitely below 1%.

So I need to diversify revenue streams if I want to maintain a high output well into the future. Sure I love writing for the sake of writing, if I didn't I certainly wouldn't still be hanging around - but making money from a hobby is always better than not.

I don't even want to put ads up, I really don't. I've tried to avoid it for a long time because I hate 'em and I know most tech literate guys (a large % of TRP) use an ad blocker anyway so the revenue even on the kind of views I get is going to be pitiful. But it's at least an extra something. Why shouldn't I be rewarded for my work? Why shouldn't GLO? Why is it noble to tirelessly produces mountains of content on the blog and the forum, but the minute you make any move towards monetisation you're this untrustworthy asshole who's just in it for the money?

I've been on this board before most people even knew what TRP was. So has GLO. Is there anything wrong with either of us making money out of our hobby? I don't think so. Successful people monetise their success, it's a fair and honest hustle that doesn't harm anybody. What's so bad about giving value to people who have given you value? Not a thing wrong with it in my opinion.

If GLO's built up a lot of goodwill, he's earned it. And I'd like to think the same of myself and all the other prolific contributors on the red pill and in the wider sphere.

When you're asking for donations/subscriptions, emphasize what someone will learn from reading your

more privileged material. Give them the hook, but not the fish yet. This could be something like "For \$1, you have access to buy any of my newer articles for \$1-\$5 a piece and learn better ways to improve your life through Machiavellian styles." Give them the list of articles you've written and let them buy the titles to gain access. For each higher payment or subscription, give people more benefits. You put in that people paying for more expensive subscriptions can get a preview look of an article and help you write it. Instead, phrase things more like this, "For \$20 a month, you get exclusive access to newer content before even being published as well as adding our voice to a dialogue with me in shaping the article." (Maybe not have the last half of that sentence, but something like how privileged they are to engage and talk to you directly about these topics.)

You're just emphasizing the the benefits you'll receive from people instead of what they'll receive. I know your content has been historically good, but I just don't know if I'm interested in paying for future content (but I can be convinced otherwise). Here's another idea, give people a referral link to use where if people use that link and you get more traffic to your blog, they get one free article that would be worth \$1-\$5. Say something like this, "if my writing has helped you in any way, please use this referral link to give to someone you believe could be helped by my writing. If just 2 people use your referral link, I'll give you access to one of my newer paid articles. Please do not spam this link to your friends, only use it for people that will actually benefit."
