We don't plan on leaving the funds in bitcoin for long. The value is mildy steady for our purposes at the moment, I'll be exchanging it to USD as quickly as possible.

There are a few private exchanges in my area that have assured me they will buy bit coin without personal information- but rest assured, even if the exchanges hold on to your information, I'm exchanging it to USD and cashier's check, it will be untraceable back to you!

We decided this was the only way to maintain anonymity, though the correct way to do this would be making a non-profit and paying the proper taxes, we don't think we'll be dealing with much cash in the first place, and secondly, that would compromise our ability to do this anonymously.

The feminists' biggest weapon is public shame. The victims of which we aim to help. We don't want to become victims ourselves!
