The person he likes best is probably the person he identifies himself as, and thus you can slowly figure out if your son sees himself as masculine, feminine, etc... Once you've figured that out, give him the right role models. The end goal is to make your son feel high self worth, valued, and have high esteem. Being a man has little to do with it.
