To add one final point, a friend of mine tried to run an investment property out of SF. Guy stopped paying rent entirely for two months and it still cost him about 7k-8k and about 40-45 days before he got the guy out.

For example, you first have to serve a notice to pay rent or quit. Then you have to file an unlawful detainer (\$240 filing fee and more in attorney fees if you don't know how to fill it out). Then its at least \$60-\$70 per tenant that needs to be served for the first 3-5 attempts. If you don't serve them (probably because they are avoiding service), its \$20 for post and mail ex parte and at least another \$50 per tenant served in this manner. Then you're waiting 15 days. If they answer on the 14th day, now you have to prepare your case and set it for trial. Usually the courts set the case 2-3 weeks out. Sure you can theoretically include all these costs in judgment, and even put in attorney fee provision into the lease, but collecting the judgment is a whole new mess.
