I'm a developer of Solidity on Ethereum and been using BTC/ETH for years. Buying into the 'stock' at a combined market cap of 100B today will look like the best investment opportunity in hindsight when it's starts pushing 400B - 600B market cap.

Facebook, Apple, etc are valued all at 1T. Global crypto market by 2027 is forecasted by Deloitte and other's to be 10% of World GDP (around 10T).

If he is getting a medical degree or something equally high paying, then great. If it's some arts or humanities degree, then good luck with that.

You can reference this post in a years time and you will see I am more than right about the outcome.

I'll be getting a degree, but it's free in my country, I agree that it's stupid to pay for.

Nonetheless, it was a risky investment at 10\$ and still is today, I would never advise anyone to invest more then 1-3% of their total investments in these currencies, and I doubt a young student is that rich.

You saying these assets are "not risky" shows how little you know about investing. These assets have huge volatility and haven't been around for more then a few years. They are risky. Sure they might still be a good investment, but saying they don't have high risk is just plain stupid.
