Emmanuel Macron wants to ban men from following women and asking for their phone number under new plans to end the 'macho' culture in France.

The 39-year-old French President vowed to crackdown on harassment on public transport and in the street when he was on the election trail earlier this year.

A Brief Summary

"A working party set up by, Marlene Schiappa, the under-secretary for gender equality, is now looking to produce legislation making it illegal to harass people in a public place - and this could mean outlawing wolf-whistles."

- (e) Forcibly transferring children of the group to another group.

— Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide, Article 2[3]

Article 3 defines the crimes that can be punished under the convention:

- (a) Genocide;
- (b) Conspiracy to commit genocide; (c) Direct and public incitement to commit genocide;
- (d) Attempt to commit genocide;
- (e) Complicity in genocide.

— Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide, Article 3[3]

MISOGYNY will now be considered a hate crime by North Yorkshire Police.

In July last year, Nottinghamshire Police became the first force to classify unwanted sexual or verbal advances towards women, including catcalling and wolf whistling, as hate crimes, in a move to tackle sexist abuse.

The crime will be defined as any criminal offence perceived by a female victim or any other person, to be motivated by a hostility or prejudice based on her gender.
