I'm no psychologist, but it's been my experience that humor for men and women are different. This is all anecdotal, but I wouldn't be surprised if many others have had similar experiences. Just one more thing that helps them establish social standing and boundaries. The other thing is that I think our respective humors may bleed over into each other occasionally, like irony and schadenfreude. Perhaps it's for different reasons, or perhaps, being master chameleons, they simply pretend to find humor in things men find humorous. I wouldn't know.
