You have to get 10 upvotes on comments before you can submit posts.

Fairly new and tiny userbase.

Userbase seems like normal people.

SLOW. Go there and click around to see how bad it is. Not sure about long term reliability, but it takes a while to open a post, and I get error 503s a lot.

No email address required for account creation. No account required to lurk.

It's a regular upvote/downvote system like reddit.

Largest userbase (# of members is high, # of votes/comments is low).

Userbase seems like normal people.

Most reliable of the three. Isn't slow like Ruqqus and doesn't go down like Voat.

No email required for account creation. No account required to lurk.

No downvotes. Instead they have two different types of upvotes.
