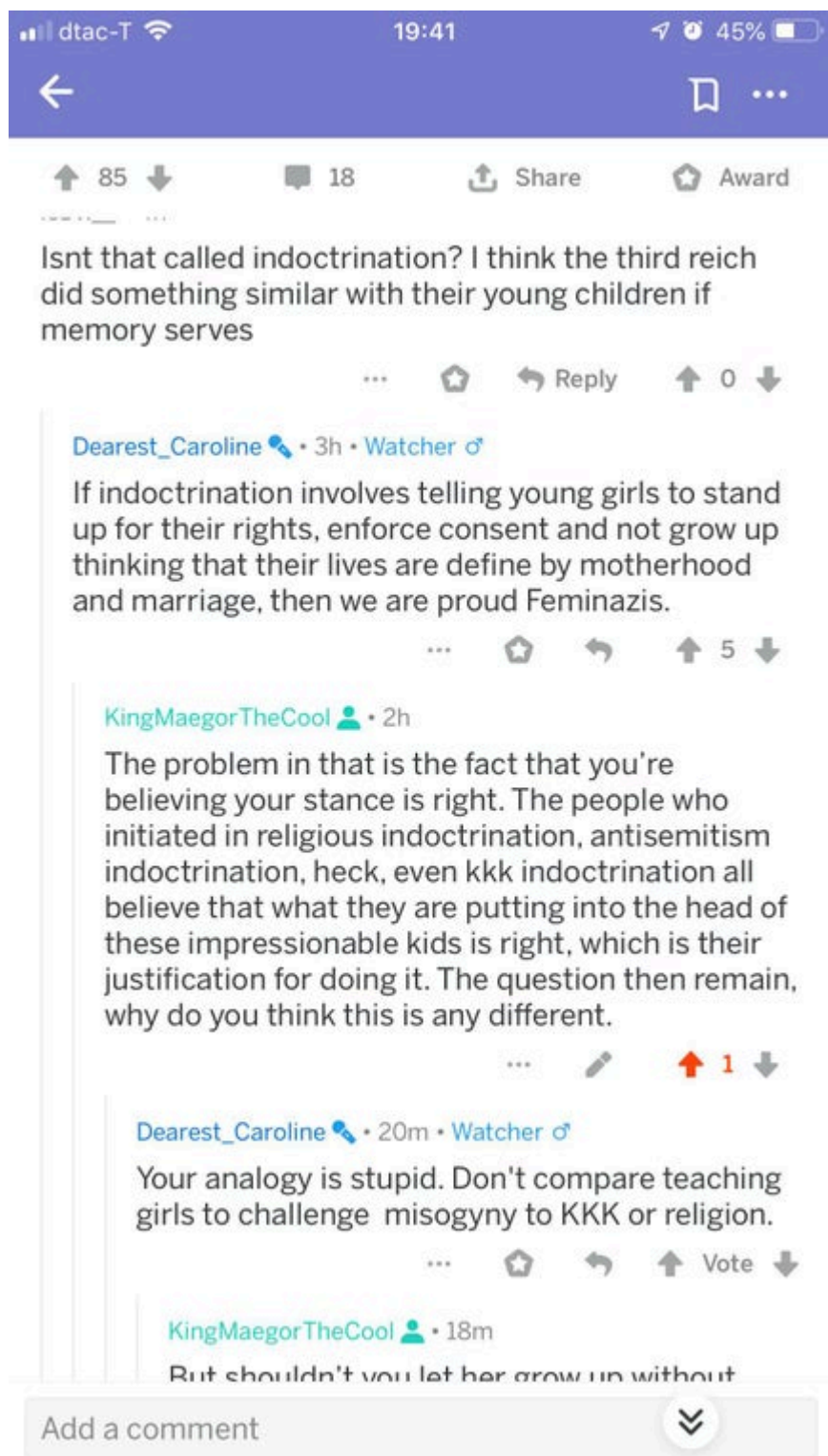


Got ban from r/witchesvsPatriachy for saying that maybe you should not indoctrinated a child from a young age
